The proposed project is to pump and move water to groundwater wells to recharge the water. He encouraged the RCD to get involved with the Reclamation District 108 projects.

Gobel moved to approve the Colusa Glenn Sub Watershed Subcontract Agreement 2025-2028. The motion was seconded by Struckmeyer. The motion carried with 4 Ayes, 0 Noes, 2 Absent, 0 Abstain, 0 Vacant

#4: Ratify Associate Directors resignation dated back to last meeting attended, April 20th, 2021

Director Beth Nall requested that current Associate Director, Jennifer Sanders sends in a written resignation letter.

1. Director requirements: Ethics and Anti-Harassment Training
